

Student Entitlement

All students in Years 8–11 are entitled to:

- Find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point.
- Hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships.
- Understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

Opportunities for Access

A number of events, integrated into the school careers programme, will offer providers the opportunity to come into school to speak to pupils and/or their parents or carers. These may include:

- Careers fairs
- Assemblies
- Employer and provider engagement events
- Curriculum-linked sessions
- PSHE lessons
- Mock interviews and skills workshops
