Dear Parents/Carers

After the past four weeks of challenge, we have welcomed the majority of the pupils and staff back this week, and hopefully with no additional cases of COVID we plan to have all our 'bubbles' back in on Monday for the first time this term. As the school returns to 'normal' the Government announced this week that Kent will move into tier three when the national lockdown ends next Wednesday.

Tier 3 guidance:

Although there is no specific tier 3 education guidance that has been published so far, the general restrictions for tier 3 are likely to have an impact on those schools that had been hoping to host live Christmas events. Under tier three, schools should not host performances/events with an audience. St Anthony's still wish to ensure the pupils will have the opportunity for seasonal celebrations which are COVID Safe.

To raise much needed funds for the PTFA we are holding a virtual raffle. There will be a range of prizes and we will post a photo of these on ClassDojo in due course. Tickets go on sale on Monday 30th November, £1 for a strip of 5. If you wish your child to have a Christmas lunch and you are not eligible for Free School Meals, the cost will be £2.30. A letter will be sent out soon so you can book your child in for this.

The 16th December will also be our Christmas Jumper Day so we look forward to seeing the range of jumpers on display that day.

As we are not able to have the Christmas Fayre, the PTFA is organizing an In School Mini Fayre for pupils on 17th December with more details to follow.
